<b>Name of the indicator</b>	<b>11.6.1 Proportion of municipal waste generated according to the treatment operation to total municipal generated</b>
<b>Sustainable Development Goal</b>	Goal 11. Sustainable cities and communities
<b>Target</b>	11.6 By 2030, reduce the adverse per capita environmental impact of cities, including by paying special attention to air quality and municipal and other waste management
<b>Definition</b>	Percentage of municipal waste designated for recycling, composting or fermentation, incineration or landfilling to total municipal waste generated within a year.
<b>Unit</b>	percent [%]
<b>Available dimensions</b>	designated for recycling
<b>Methodological explanations</b>	<p><b>Municipal wastes</b> are defined as the wastes generated in households (excluding end of life vehicles) as well as waste which does not contain hazardous substances, coming from other waste producers, which in their nature or composition are similar to wastes generated in households mixed municipal waste remain mixed municipal waste, even if they have been processed, which did not change substantially their attributes.</p> <p><b>Data on municipal wastes</b> are gathered from units responsible for municipal waste collection and from units responsible for municipal waste treatment. Information comprise waste coded with code 20: Municipal waste including separately collected fractions, and wastes coded with code 15 01: Waste packaging (including separately collected municipal packaging waste) provided they originate from municipal sector.</p> <p>For 2010-2014 data: classification of waste and Catalogue of Waste including hazardous waste list is stipulated by Regulation of Minister of Environment issued on 27 September 2001 on the Waste Catalogue (Journal of Law 2001 No. 112, item 1206).</p> <p>Since 2015 data: classification of waste and Catalogue of Waste including hazardous waste list is stipulated by Regulation of Minister of Environment issued on 9 December 2014 on the Waste Catalogue (Journal of Law 2014, item 1923).</p>
<b>Data source</b>	Statistics Poland
<b>Data availability</b>	Annual data Since 2010.
<b>Notes</b>	The presented indicator (11.6.1 Proportion of municipal waste generated according to the treatment operation to total municipal generated) is a proxy indicator to the one adopted in the official list of indicators of the UN Sustainable Development Goals. The replacement of the original indicator ( <a href="#">11.6.1 Proportion of municipal solid waste collected and managed in controlled facilities out of total municipal waste generated, by cities</a> ) is due to the inability to obtain data for it. The proxy indicator has been selected so as to most fully reflect the essence of the observed phenomenon. Estimated data on the management of municipal waste up to 2022. Since 2023, the data are not comparable with previous years due to a change in the calculation method.
