<b>Methodological explanations</b>	<p>Persons who are over 18 years of age and have not reached retirement age, unemployed and not performing any other gainful work, capable and ready to take up full-time employment and registered with the appropriate district employment office for their place of residence (permanent or temporary) and seeking employment or other gainful work.</p> <p>The unemployed include disabled persons capable and ready to take up employment for at least half of this working time, not studying at school, with the exception of schools for adults (or taking an external exam from this school) or universities in the part-time study system, and seeking employment.</p> <p>A disabled person is a person who, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 27 August 1997 on vocational and social rehabilitation and employment of disabled persons (Journal of Laws 1997 No. 123 item 776, as amended), has a decision on the degree of disability or an equivalent decision:</p>
