Methodological explanations	<p>Morbidity is the frequency of new cases of a disease in the studied population.</p> <p>Bacillary dysentery is an infectious disease of the gastrointestinal tract caused by bacteria of the <i>Shigella</i> genus. Transmission of the infection occurs by transferring bacteria on the skin of the hands or objects to the oral cavity through contaminated food and water.</p>
