<b>Name of the indicator</b>	<b>3.B.2 Average number of beds in health resort hospital and health resort sanatoria</b>
<b>Sustainable Development Goal</b>	Goal 3. Good health and well-being
<b>Priority</b>	Improving the quality and availability of healthcare infrastructure
<b>Definition</b>	Average number of beds in spa hospitals and spa sanatoriums.
<b>Unit</b>	pieces
<b>Available dimensions</b>	total
<b>Methodological explanations</b>	<p><b>The average number of beds</b> is the sum of the number of beds as of the end of each month divided by 12, i.e. the number of months in a year.</p> <p><b>A spa hospital</b> is a spa treatment facility whose tasks include providing a patient who has been referred for spa treatment or spa rehabilitation with:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) 24-hour health care services in inpatient conditions;</li> <li>2) 24-hour medical and nursing care;</li> <li>3) procedures specified in the treatment program;</li> <li>4) use of natural medicinal resources and spa treatment facilities;</li> <li>5) health education.</li> </ol> <p><b>A spa sanatorium</b> is a spa treatment facility. The tasks of a sanatorium include providing a patient who has been referred for spa treatment or spa rehabilitation with:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) 24-hour health care services in inpatient conditions;</li> <li>2) medical care and 24-hour nursing care;</li> <li>3) procedures specified in the treatment program;</li> <li>4) preventive services;</li> <li>5) health education.</li> </ol>
