| <b>Methodological explanations</b>  | <p>A graduate is a person who has completed the highest programmatic class in a given type of school and received a certificate of completion of this school - applies to graduates in schools covered by the education system.</p> <p>A graduate of studies receives a diploma of completion of studies in a specific field and profile confirming higher education and a professional title:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Bachelor's degree, engineer's degree or equivalent confirming higher education at the same level - in the case of first-cycle studies;</li> <li>2. Master's degree, master of engineering or equivalent confirming higher education at the same level - in the case of second-cycle studies and uniform master's studies.</li> </ol> <p>A field of study is a separate part of one or several areas of education, implemented at the university in a manner specified by the education program.</p> <p>A public university is a university established by the state represented by the appropriate authority or public administration body.</p> |
