Methodological explanations	<p>Advice provided – a service provided in an outpatient setting, including at home by a doctor, dentist or psychologist.</p> <p>Outpatient health care involves healthcare services provided by service providers to people who do not require treatment in 24-hour or all-day conditions. Guaranteed services in the scope of outpatient specialist care are provided in specialist clinics in cases resulting from the health condition (also at the patient's home) by a doctor with appropriate qualifications or by another person who is authorized to provide specialist services.</p> <p>Guaranteed services include diagnostic and therapeutic activities (including testing of collected biological material) to the extent necessary to provide the service in accordance with current medical knowledge.</p> <p>Guaranteed services are provided in the case of:</p> <p>The service provider provides the patient with the following free of charge to the extent necessary to provide guaranteed services:</p> <p>Outpatient specialist services are provided on the basis of a referral issued by a health insurance physician.</p> <p>A referral is not required for services provided by:</p> <p>and in the case of:</p>
