Methodological explanations	<p>Outpatient health services are the provision of primary or specialist health care and medical rehabilitation services, provided in conditions that do not require their provision in a stationary and 24-hour mode in an appropriately equipped, permanent room. These services may be provided in the premises of the enterprise, including in a vehicle intended for the provision of these services, or at the patient's place of stay.</p> <p>Spa treatment is an organized activity consisting in the provision of health care services in the field of spa treatment or spa rehabilitation, conducted in a spa by spa treatment facilities or outside the spa in hospitals and sanatoriums located in equipped underground mining excavations, using natural conditions.</p>
