<b>Name of the indicator</b>	<b>6.D.10 The difference between the percentage of the population using water and sewage systems in rural areas</b>
<b>Sustainable Development Goal</b>	Goal 6. Clean water and sanitation
<b>Priority</b>	Development of water and sewage infrastructure
<b>Definition</b>	The difference between the percentage of the population living in in rural areas using water systems and the percentage of the population living in in rural areas sewerage system.
<b>Unit</b>	percentage points
<b>Available dimentions</b>	total
<b>Methodological explanations</b>	<p>The indicator value is the result of subtracting the values of the following two indicators:</p> <p>Percentage of population using water systems in cities in the total population living in cities areas (minus)</p> <p>and</p> <p>Percentage of population using sewage systems in cities areas in the total population living in cities areas (minus).</p> <p>Data on using water include the population living in cities areas in residential buildings and in collective dwellings connected to the using water systems.</p> <p>Data on the use of sewage systems include the population living in cities areas in residential buildings and in collective dwellings connected to the sewage systems.</p>
