Methodological explanations	<p>The indicator value is the result of subtracting the values of the following two indicators:</p> <p>Percentage of population using water systems in cities in the total population living in cities areas (minus)</p> <p>and</p> <p>Percentage of population using sewage systems in cities areas in the total population living in cities areas (minus).</p> <p>Data on using water include the population living in cities areas in residential buildings and in collective dwellings connected to the using water systems.</p> <p>Data on the use of sewage systems include the population living in cities areas in residential buildings and in collective dwellings connected to the sewage systems.</p>
