Methodological explanations	<p>Data regarding employment concern persons performing work providing earnings or income.</p> <p>Employed persons include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. a. persons employed on the basis of an employment relationship (i.e. employment contract, appointment, election or nomination) or service relationship for a definite and indefinite period of time, according to full-time and part-time work schedules; 2. b. employers and own-account workers including contributing family workers; 3. c. outworkers; 4. d. agents (until 2021); 5. e. members of agricultural production cooperatives; 6. f. clergy fulfilling priestly obligations. <p>When determining the number of employees, each working person is listed only once. For this purpose, a main workplace is assigned to her. Data on people working in the national economy are presented in relation to their main workplace.</p> <p>Data on the number of people employed in the national economy in the main workplace are given in persons as at the end of December.</p>
