<b>Sustainable Development Goal</b>	Goal 9. Industry, innovation and infrastructure
<b>Priority</b>	Increased competitiveness of the region by increasing the research and innovation potential (Development of institutional potential for research and development, supporting cooperation between the research sector and the economy)
<b>Definition</b>	The indicator determines the share of invention applications from a given voivodeship in the total number of inventions submitted to the Patent Office, expressed in %.

<b>Methodological explanations</b>	<p>A reported invention (Patent application) is a solution to a specific problem of a technical nature, reported for protection to the appropriate office accepting the application, in order to obtain patent protection for a given invention.</p> <p>Source of definition: Act of 30 June 2000 - Industrial Property Law Place of publication: (Journal of Laws of 2003, item 1170).</p> <p>National procedure for reporting inventions for patenting (National procedure) - a procedure for all types of applications submitted directly to the patent office of a given country - from the territory of that country and from abroad under the Paris Convention of 1883.</p>
