Priority	Increased competitiveness of the region by increasing the research and innovation potential (Development of institutional potential for research and development, supporting cooperation between the research sector and the economy)
Definition	Total internal expenditure incurred in a given year on R&D activities conducted in the reporting unit, regardless of the source of funds, in relation to GDP.

Methodological explanations	<p>Research and Development (R&D) Creative work undertaken in a methodical manner to increase the resources of knowledge - including knowledge of mankind, culture and society - and to create new applications for existing knowledge.</p> <p>R&D includes: 1. scientific research - basic research - applied research (identical to application research) 2. development work.</p> <p>Internal R&D expenditures: Expenditures incurred in the reporting year for R&D work performed in the reporting entity, regardless of the source of the funds. They include both current expenditures and capital expenditures on fixed assets related to R&D activities, but do not include depreciation of fixed assets.</p>
