<b>Methodological explanations</b>	<p>Internal R&amp;D personnel, Working in R&amp;D English name: Internal R&amp;D personnel            Definition: Persons working (employees, working owners and unpaid helping family members) in a statistical unit who contribute to the internal research and development activities of that unit.</p> <p>FTE - full-time equivalents - conversion units used to determine the actual involvement in research and development activities; one full-time equivalent (FTE) means one person-year devoted exclusively to R&amp;D activities.</p> <p>Research and experimental development (R&amp;D) - creative work undertaken in a methodical manner in order to increase the resources of knowledge - including knowledge about mankind, culture and society - and to create new applications for existing knowledge.</p>
